The proposed upper limits on Noise Levels are excessively prohibitive, as they would exclude many common residential activities, including lawn mowers (electric - 75 dB, Petrol 95 dB, hedge trimmers and chain saws (100 - 105 dB), and power tools (80 - 100

The reason(s) db). I appreciate the intent to have quiet residential neighbourhoods, but the maximum for my noise level is too low. Long grass in summer in Twizel is a fire risk, and the current submission settings would make it illegal to mow lawns! All activities shall be designed and are: conducted so as to ensure that the following noise levels are not exceeded at any point

within the boundary of any other site within the Residential Zone: Daytime 50 dBA L10 Daytime (including any Sunday) 70 dBA Lmax Nighttime 40 dBA L10 Nighttime (excluding 8am to 9pm Sunday) 70 dBA Lm
