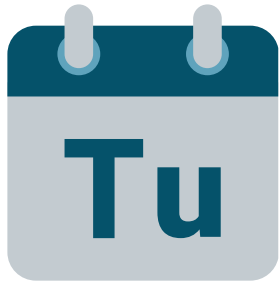
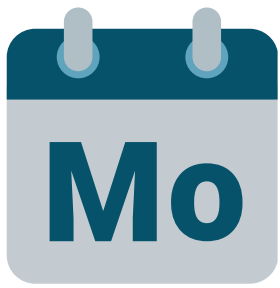

- Household rubbish that cannot be recycled.



- No liquids, paints, chemicals or full oil containers.



- Loose items only - please don't tie recycling inside plastic bags.
- Paper, cardboard, newspaper, magazines, boxes, egg trays.
- Plastics (# 1,2 & 5 only). Please rinse containers & remove bottle lids.



- No organic waste, no glass.
- No household rubbish, nappies, clothing, shoes, polystyrene or polystyrene meat trays #6, cellophane packaging, bubble wrap, plastic film or wrap, garden hose, ceramics or pottery.
- Buckets and containers over 3 litres cannot be recycled.



- Food waste, garden waste, pruned branches, meat and bones, dog excrement (wrapped in paper), paper towels, pizza boxes, fish and chip paper.



- No bamboo, cabbage tree leaves, rhubarb leaves, flax, palm leaves, shells and shellfish.



- Clean glass jars & bottles (remove lids).

Please have bins out by 7am during daylight saving hours and 8am over winter. Routes and pick up times may vary so please ensure your bins are out on time. Maximum weight is 75kg

Bin lids must be fully closed. Items or bags next to or on top of bins will not be collected. Recycling bins contaminated with rubbish or glass will not be collected.
