TOMORROW'S MACKENZIE KA AWATEA HŌU

Mackenzie District Council is planning for the future with a review of the Mackenzie District Plan. We're updating the District Plan to ensure we can grow in a sustainable way, while protecting the things that make the Mackenzie District special. MDC is required to review the District Plan through the Resource Management Act (RMA) to ensure it is up to date and relevant.

What is the District Plan?

A District Plan is essentially the rule book that sets district-wide rules for sustainably managing how people use, subdivide and develop land, what and where they can build and also what kind of activities they can undertake without being required to obtain a resource consent.

Stage Four

This Mackenzie District Plan Review is being undertaken in stages. We are currently working on Stage Four of the District Plan Review, which covers the following topics.

- Airport Noise
