Additional comments:

We can do better at the source. We already have curbside bins, lets add a greenwaste bin. We also need to bundle our cardboard waste separately.

We should keep all our organic greenwaste in our region and compost or reuse it locally. This includes organic household and business food waste. By processing and using it locally we reduce transport costs and create soil building resources for our local environment.

The organic wastes from our tourists and visitors should be a revenue generator for our region.

To achieve this we need a dedicated composting facility. We already have all the inputs for good compost. We have high nitrogen food waste, fish waste and grass clippings. We have high carbon yardwaste, prunings, leaves, wilding pine chip and forestry waste. We also have locally available animal manure. These, combined with the right amount of air and moisture makes for well balanced compost.

This compost can be a resource for local gardeners, caretakers and farmers to improve the soil sustainably in the region.

We need to lead by example. The work we do can inspire other regions to do the same. The facility we create should be a benchmark for organic waste composting in a stable, environmentally friendly way.

Please turn our organic waste into resources and build us a composting facility.
