Designations

Introduction

A designation is a planning technique used by Ministers of the Crown, local authorities, and network utility operators approved as requiring authorities under s167 of the RMA. Only requiring authorities can seek designations for land.

A designation is a form of 'spot zoning' over a site, area, or route in a District Plan. The designation authorises the requiring authority's work and activity on the site, area or route without the need to comply with the land use rules of the District Plan. A designation:

- enables a requiring authority to undertake the works within the designated area without the need for a land use consent.
- sets the parameters under which the activity can occur.

The underlying zone of the District Plan remains over the site and applies to any other activities that are for a purpose different to the designation purpose (or activities undertaken by a party other than the requiring authority). Therefore, any activity or works outside the scope of a designation will require resource consent unless the activity or works are a permitted activity.

Conditions

1. The following structures, buildings, equipment and ancillary land uses to maintain the operation of the facility may be established and/or undertaken within the defined area entitled *Mt Mary Transmission Site KL-1B Designation Area* shown on the designation plan supporting this designation:
 - a. The upgrade, repair or repositioning of the existing tower and existing equipment building within the designated area.
 - b. The installation of dish antennas with a maximum diameter less than 4.0 metres.
 - c. Broadcasting, Telecommunication and Radiocommunication antennas including whip, grid, yagi, dipoles and panels or similar ancillary equipment, but no single antenna shall have a solid frontal surface area of greater than 4.0m², unless otherwise specified above or being a replacement of an existing antenna.
 - d. Equipment Cabinets, generators and their auxiliaries not exceeding 3m in height and 18m² in floor plan area.
 - e. The maintenance of the land and vegetation within the designated area to ensure the ongoing operation of the facility.
 - f. The maximum reflectivity index of the exterior of any structure, building or outdoor equipment within the area subject to this designation shall be 40%.



1. The boundaries of the designation are as shown on Drawing 6510257-G5-004 (Attached as Attachment A) provided that the part of the designation relating to the corridors identified for access, electricity and sewage shall be uplifted in accordance with Section 182 of the RMA, when the easements for the above matters are registered on the Certificate of Title for the expanded Wastewater Treatment Plant site.
2. The land use activities undertaken within the designation shall generally be as shown on Drawing 6510257-G5-005 (Attached as Attachment B).
3. The land use activities undertaken within the designation shall generally be as shown on Drawing 6510257-G5-005 (Attached as Attachment B).
4. All activities (other than construction activities) shall be conducted such that noise arising from such activities does not exceed the following noise limits:

All activities, other than emergency service warning devices and sirens, shall be designed and

conducted so as to ensure that the following noise limits are not exceeded at any point within a Residential Zone or any point within the notional boundaries of any residential unit on another site:

Daytime 55dBA L10

Nighttime 40dBA L10 70dBA Lmax

except that for farming activities this standard shall only apply to noise from stationary motors or equipment.

5. Tree removal shall be limited to that reasonably required for the upgrading and effective operation of the Twizel Wastewater Treatment Plant.
6. Where feasible, the Requiring Authority shall include locally sourced native planting in any landscaping.
7. If non-compliance with any condition of this designation occurs, the Requiring Authority shall:
 - a. Undertake such corrective actions or remedial measures as are reasonably necessary to avoid, remedy or mitigate the adverse effects arising from the non-compliance;
 - b. Advise the Planning and Regulations Manager, Mackenzie District Council of the nature and scale of the non-compliance within 24 hours; and
 - c. Implement measures such that the non-compliance does not reoccur.
8. The Wastewater Treatment Plant will be bunded and landscaped as provided in the application received 9 August 2017 to provide a visual screen. The bund will be maintained at all times.

Conditions

1. The exterior cladding of all above ground buildings, reservoirs tanks and cabinets are to be finished in colour(s) that have a light reflectance value of less than 4096 and are to be in a range of neutral browns, greens, and grey colours.
2. The maximum height of any structures is to be 9.60m¹ measured between ground level at any point and the highest part of the building immediately above that point and excluding aerials and other telecommunication antennas that are attached to buildings and are no more than 1m

squared in area on any side, 1200mm in diameter or 12m above ground level.

3. The maximum gross floor area of all buildings within the designation is to be 400m² measured from the exterior faces of the exterior walls.
4. The reservoirs and plant room are to be set back a minimum distance of 8m from the boundary of State Highway 8 and 2m from the south eastern boundary of the designation area.
5. Landscaping of the site shall partially screen views of buildings from beyond the site and:
 - a. include a range of species, maturity and sizes of (predominantly Indigenous) plantings;
 - b. if appropriate, mounding and fencing along all boundaries of the site other than the south west boundary;
 - c. If any of the trees which contribute to the partial screening of buildings are removed, die, or become diseased, a replacement tree(s) is to be planted in its place within the next planting season.
6. Any bundling and fencing around the boundary of the designation area will comprise post and wire deer fencing of up to 2.2m in height and bunding of up to 1.5m in height.
7. The operation of the water treatment station shall be conducted so as to ensure the following noise limits are not exceeded by stationary motors or equipment at any point within the notional boundary of any dwelling:

7am - 9pm 55 dBA L10 Monday to Friday and 9am - 5pm Saturday, excluding public holidays and

9pm - 7am 40 dBA L10 Monday to Friday and 8pm-9am Saturday and public holidays and 70 dBA Lmax.

"Notional boundary" is defined as a line 20 metres from part of any living accommodation or the legal boundary where this is closer to the living accommodation.

8. The use of outdoor exterior lighting within the designation shall be limited to servicing, repairs, maintenance and any emergency related purposes. All fixed exterior lighting is to be directed away from adjacent properties and roads. All intermittent outdoor lighting shall be shielded from above in such a manner that the edge of the shield shall be below the whole of the light source.
9. A Construction Management Plan shall be prepared and submitted with any Outline Plan prior to any building or earthworks occurring on the site. The purpose of the Construction Management Plan shall be to set out the specific practices and procedures recommended by suitably qualified and experienced persons to be adopted to ensure compliance with conditions on the designation and otherwise to minimise the effects of construction activities on traffic safety, and on surrounding properties and water quality, including the control of erosion, sediment, stormwater and runoff associated with construction, and the management of any potential contamination.
10. If kōiwi (human skeletal remains), wōhi taoka (resource or object of importance including greenstone/pounamu), wahi tapu (place or feature of special significance) or other artefact materials are discovered, work shall stop to allow for a site inspection by the appropriate Runaka and their advisors and the Heritage New Zealand Regional Archaeologist. In the case of kōiwi, the New Zealand Police must also be advised. These people will determine if the discovery is likely to be extensive and whether a thorough site investigation will be required. Materials discovered should be handled and removed by takata whenua who possess knowledge of tikanga (protocol) appropriate to their removal or preservation and an appointed qualified archaeologist.

Advice Note: All pre 1900 archaeological sites, including Māori archaeological sites, are protected under the Heritage New Zealand Pouhere Toanga Act 2014. Any damage, modification or destruction of such sites require an archaeological authority under that Act.

Memoranda of Understanding between the New Zealand Defence Force and the Minister of Conservation specify conditions on military activities which occur within sites of special conservation significance.

Tekapo Military Training Area - Eastern Training Zone and Western Training Zone:

1. Activities within the designated area shall be undertaken in general accordance with the Tekapo Military Training Area Sustainable Land Management Strategy and the Range Standing Orders for the Tekapo Military Training Area.
2. Range Standing Orders shall be established to ensure that within 20 metres on either side of the

streambed of Te Wai-a-Kohe / Irishman Creek:

- i. activity that has the potential to damage the riparian vegetation is restricted;
- ii. tracked vehicles are prohibited.

3. The New Zealand Defence Force shall manage and control activities on the site such that firing of weapons with a calibre greater than 40mm (and which utilise high explosive ammunition) and "battle simulation" explosions do not take place within that part of the designated training area east of a line referred to as "Easting 139300".
4. The Sustainable Land Management Strategy for the Tekapo Military Training Area be maintained as to objectives and policies, reviewed within 12 months of the designation being provided for within the Mackenzie District Plan and thereafter reviewed every five years or as required to address new or changing issues and information.
