<u>Resolved</u> that \$50,000 be transferred from the Tekapo Works and Services Operating Reserve surplus of \$125,078 to the Tekapo Roading Capital Reserve account to offset the current year's operating deficit of \$27,570 and provide a small buffer to carry into the new financial year.
