Plan Change 20 – Strategic Chapters

July 2020

Proposed Plan Change 20 is part of Stage 1 of the review of the Mackenzie District Plan and includes in its scope the following changes to the Mackenzie District Plan. Changes to other provisions of the Mackenzie District Plan are not within the scope of Plan Change 20.

1. Primary Changes

- 1.1. Delete “Section 1 – Introduction” in full.
- 1.2. Delete “Section 2 – Policy and Legal Framework” in full.
- 1.3. Delete “Section 4 – Takata Whenua” in full.
- 1.4. Insert the following new chapters, as contained in Appendix 1, within a new ‘Part 1 – Introduction and General Provisions’:
 - Mihi
 - Purpose
 - Description of the District
 - Statutory Context
 - General Approach
 - Cross Boundary Matters
 - Relationships Between Spatial Layers
 - Definitions
 - Abbreviations
 - Glossary
 - National policy statements and New Zealand Coastal Policy Statement
 - National environmental standards
 - Regulations
 - Water Conservation Orders
 - Mana Whenua
- 1.5. Insert the following new chapters, as contained in Appendix 2, within a new ‘Strategic Direction’ section, within a new ‘Part 2 – District-Wide Matters’:
 - A Thriving Community
 - Mana Whenua
 - Natural Environment
 - Urban Form and Development

2. Consequential Changes

- 2.1. Delete the following definitions in Section 3 – Definitions:

Lake: means a permanent body of freshwater entirely or nearly surrounded by land.

River: means a permanently or intermittently flowing body of freshwater with a formed and recognisable bed, but does not include any artificial watercourse (including an irrigation canal, water supply race, canal for the supply of water for electricity power generation and farm drainage canal).
