

Proposed Change to the Mackenzie District Plan Plan Change 17: Vegetation Clearance – Temporary Suspension of Exemption Summary of Decisions Requested

Pursuant to Clause 7 of the First Schedule to the Resource Management Act 1991 Mackenzie District Council gives public notice that it has prepared a **summary of decisions requested** received in relation to **Proposed Plan Change 17: Vegetation Clearance – Temporary Suspension of Exemption** which proposes to suspend oversowing and topdressing exemptions contained within the Mackenzie District Plan in relation to clearance of short tussock grasslands (rule 12.1.1.g) and cushion and mat vegetation and associated communities (12.1.1.h).
