NOTE: The above information will be kept by the Mackenzie District Council but may be used only for lawful official purposes and will not be generally available to the public. However, section 35 of the Dog Control Act 1996 allows the name and address of the owner of any specified dog to be made available to any person who has made a written application for that information.

Before supplying the information, the council must be satisfied of the identity of the applicant and that the information is required for one of a limited number of specified purposes, such as returning a lost dog to its owner or seeking compensation for damage.

## Sections 52, 53 and 54A, Dog Control Act 1996

- if it is found at large on any land or premises other than a public place or a private way without the consent (express or implied) of the occupier or person in charge of the land or premises; or
- if it is found at large in any public place or in any private way in contravention of any regulations or bylaw.

## Obligations of dog owner and owner's property

### Sections 52A, Dog Control Act 1996

- that the dog is under the direct control of a person;
- or that the dog is confined within the land or premises in such a way that it cannot freely leave the land or premises.

Please note: the above requirements relate to the Dog Control Act 1996. The Mackenzie District Council Dog Control Policy and Bylaw identifies various specific areas in our district which are set aside as Dog Exercise Areas or Leash Control Areas or Dog Prohibited Areas. Please refer to the Bylaw so you are aware of those requirements. Both the Policy and Bylaw are available from the Mackenzie District Council website - [mackenzie.govt.nz](http://mackenzie.govt.nz)

From 1 July 2006, legislation came into effect meaning all new puppies need to be microchipped within two months of when they are registered. Your dog can be microchipped by any vet, and a verification certificate will be issued, which must be signed by a Veterinarian or Dog Control Officer and brought or sent to Council.

You will also need to microchip your dog if:

- You are registering your dog in New Zealand for the first time (this mainly applies to puppies).
- Your dog is classified as dangerous.
- Your dog is classified as menacing.
- Your unregistered dog is impounded for the first time from 1 July 2006.
- Your registered dog has been impounded for the second time from 1 July 2006.

Dog registration fees include a proportion of the levy that every Territorial Authority is required to pay for the administration of the National Dog Database. This levy is adjusted annually and this adjustment will be reflected in fees set for dog registration.

## Sections 54, Dog Control Act 1996

- ensure that the dog received proper care and attention and is supplied with proper and sufficient food, water and shelter, and
- ensure that the dog receives adequate exercise.

You will commit an offence and be liable on conviction to imprisonment for up to 3 months or to a fine not exceeding \$5,000, or an infringement fee of \$300 if you fail to comply with this provision.
