The ancient trail takes an unnecessary diversion from the Tengawai river and passes through a deer pen and through a deer yards. The rock art set back at 300 metres is excessive and effects too much valuable farmland that will never be irrigated. Also, an area of approximately 250 hectares has been mapped and with no real evidence of being any more significant than all the South Island .It is in the northeast corner. Also, an area of 200 hectares in Southwest corner.

I seek the following decision from the Mackenzie District Council: (give precise details)

To reroute the ancient trail to the riverbed as it is everywhere else. To shrink the rock art set back to 50 metres. To remove the large 250-hectare site where it crosses my boundary onto P103 Run 306 Silver Hill To Shrink the southwest site as no reason for it and covered by ancient trail.
