Cr McDermott requested that a report of the income and expenditure associated with the **Fairlie pensioner housing project** be made available.

It was requested that the **timing split for the Grants budgets** be amended to reflect the actual allocation dates and that a **breakdown of the consultancy costs** associated with Council's commercial activities be provided.

Cr Pullen suggested that because of the rising costs of fuel, consideration be given to reducing Council's **vehicle usage.** 

#### 2 PUKAKI AIRPORT BOARD

This report from the Manager - Finance and Administration referred to issues that needed to be resolved to ensure that Council's obligations were met with the outsourcing of the Pukaki Airport Board's accounting and finance function.
