The Twizel Swimming pool was opened in 1973 + is now 45 years old + this is evident to anyone who attempts to use the facilities there.

I believe the town would benefit from a well thought out up-grade that included a roof + heating system to make it a year round ~~system~~ facility.

The money put into the pool pumping + filtration system in 2017 makes no improvement to the user experience.

The current pool is available for a very limited period each year + during this time when the weather is hot most people are content with swimming in the lovely lakes + rivers + when the weather is too cold for them it is usually too cold for the pool also.

For the last 3 years I have enrolled my children in swimming lessons at the Twizel pool + at least half of them are cancelled each year as the water temperature is too cold.

I would also like to see better control on freedom camping - designated areas for self contained vehicles only + good signage to these designated areas. Currently it seems like a free for all with the majority in non self contained vehicles. A warden issuing on the spot fines of \$20 pay now or \$40 pay to council within 2 days would pay for itself.
