I would like to see some more discussion about the Tourism Tax in regards to Farmetay accompodation I run fametay accomposation and I totally agree that all accommodation providers should pay something BUT it should be changed more fairly I know as a farmstay we are charged only on the value of our house not the complete farm - but we only ever use the area around our house where quests can feed, Pat and take Photo's of animals - our quests don't because we are governed by Occupational and safety regulations farmstay operator I deal only with booking agents, I am not on Airbnb nor do I have a website, my booking agents pay me for each I hast and a portion of my payment goes into paying the booking agents Tourism Industry Asternoon Tourism Export Council of New Zealand Tourism N.2 all of which they belong to I understand the Tourism Tax we pay to the Mackensie District council pays for promoting the repetence District but as a farmstay wast of quests come into Fairle on a bus tour and staying at a farmstay is part of their tour not necessarily having any knowledge of our area. As a fampstay we may host between 75-100 nights per year, our quests stay in our

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home which we occupy unlike some Air bub accommodation in the area which is unoccupied by the owners and potentially can be having guests every night of the year. This is where a farmstay is a different type of accommodation I feel we are being charged the booking agents and once by the markensie District Council, yet we are hosting the least amount of nights think a fairer system needs to be looked at and I'm more than happy to answer any further guestions Thankipy for your time
