The specific provisions of the Proposal my submission relates to

The land between Ruataniwha Road and Dobson Place is proposed to be changed to Commercial Visitor Accommodation Precinct. The land contains three holes on the Twizel Disc Golf Course. If these holes were to be lost, it would be impossible to find three more holes on the Twizel green belt and so would mean the end of the Twizel Disc Golf Course. This course is one of the oldest Disc Golf Courses in New Zealand and was upgraded at considerable expense and support from The Council in 2018 to international competition standard. The course is very popular with both novice and advanced players and is highly regarded by New Zealand's Disc Golf community. It has for the past 8 years has hosted New Zealand Disc Golf Association Tour competitions attracting 130
